### **Olympic Legacy Fund / PE Sport Grant Expenditure (Sports Premium)**

#### **2013 - 2014**

##### **Summer Term 2014**

- Specialist sports/PE coaches to teach one session of PE per week for each child
- Gym and Dance specialist working alongside the PE Leader
- NQT PE courses
- PE leader training
- A variety of after school clubs – e.g. multiskills, golf etc
- Up skilling teachers in PE
- Competitions/tournaments with schools in the local area

##### **Impact**

- Increased participation in after school clubs
- More children enthusiastic and prepared for their PE curriculum sessions
- Teachers up skilled through observations of sports coaches and their planning
- Enjoyment of the competitiveness in lessons and events – e.g. sports day
- More parents involved in sports day

#### **2014-2015 (Includes provision from 2013-2015 currently in place and planned provision)**

Bowmansgreen will receive £8,000 plus £5 per pupil. This academic year this amounts to approximately £9280.

- Specialist sports/PE coaches to teach one session of PE per week for each child
  - Planning
  - Assessments
  - Gifted and talented programme for KS2
  - Lunchtime football tournaments
- Gym and Dance specialist INSET
- Up skilling teachers
- Providing more variety of extra-curricular activities
- Increase the number of children participating in extra-curricular activities
- Invite athletes for workshops

- Set up sports/play leaders
- Sporting event days involving whole community e.g. family fun days etc
- Creating consistency throughout the school by using a scheme of work
- Competitions/tournaments with schools in the local area
