Term Outline - Summer 2017

Year Group: 6

Our main themes for work this term are outlined below.

We hope this will aid you in supporting your child in the work they do at school and with homework given.

<b>English</b>	To revise and recap the major forms of fiction and non-fiction writing. To write a biography of an influential person.  To rehearse and perform scripts to an audience.
<b>Mathematics</b>	To revise and rehearse all number operations with integers and fractional numbers. To apply various methods to solve a range of real-life problems. To recap and investigate shape, space and measurement.
<b>Science</b>	Light – children will be learning about how the eye works and how we see. They will also be investigating how light travels (and not always in straight lines).
<b>DT</b>	To make 3D structures linked to other curriculum areas. To use techniques of paper engineering.
<b>ICT</b>	<b>Information Models:</b> Children will develop expertise in Word to become more familiar with the features and layout.
<b>History</b>	To further develop understanding of how life in Britain has changed since World War 2.
<b>RE</b>	To compare and contrast the three major world religions.
<b>Music</b>	To learn and perform songs for the end of year production.
<b>PE &amp; Games</b>	<b>Games</b> –Athletics, cricket and rounders. <b>Dance</b> – learning about different styles of dance and movement.
<b>PSHE</b> <b>(Personal, Social and Health Education)</b>	Considering relationships. Preparing for moving on to secondary school.
