Write a diary entry talking about your day. Include: What you did when you awoke? What jobs did you need to do? What did you see? What did you hear? Who did you talk to? What happened at the end of the day?</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> If you have done this from a man's point of view can you do it from a woman's point of view or vice versa?</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date: </p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Five</u></p> <p>You will need to draw or paint an Anglo-Saxon or Viking village. Make sure to include buildings as well as people doing daily activities.</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Can you label or add captions to your picture explaining what is happening or what certain buildings are for?</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date: </p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Six</u></p> <p>You will need to create a detailed picture of a Anglo-Saxon warrior and a Viking warrior. Label the things they are wearing and the weapons they are carrying.</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Can you add extra detail about their clothing and weapons? Can you draw an Anglo-Saxon villager and a Viking villager?</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date: </p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Seven</u></p> <p>You will need to create a 3D Viking Boat (which can be brought into school or may be photographed and put in your book).
