<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task One</u></p> <p>You need to pick two characters, from either Private Peaceful or Holes and write a character description of both.</p> <p>Remember to think about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● What they look like ● How they move ● How they speak ● Their personality ● How others respond to them <p><u>Challenge!</u></p> <p>Write a paragraph which compares and contrasts the two characters you have picked.</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature & date:</i></p> <p>.....</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Two</u></p> <p>SCIENCE: Choose two different animals from the same species and research how they have adapted to suit their environment. Produce a fact file to present your findings. Try to include at least ten different facts.</p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; background-color: #fff9e6;"> <p>Suggestions: You could compare and contrast the polar bear and the grizzly bear; the salmon and the angler fish; the Leatherback turtle and the giant tortoise of the Galapagos Islands.</p> </div> <p><u>Challenge!</u> One of the animals you research could be extinct or endangered and your fact file could have an important message to the reader.</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature & date:</i></p> <p>.....</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Three</u></p> <p>Pick something you want to try to sell (e.g. a holiday, a PlayStation or a book) and create an advertisement poster to persuade people to buy it.</p> <p>Remember to use the features of persuasive texts, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● emotive language ● rhetorical questions ● powerful verbs ● personal pronouns ● facts and statistics ● repetition <p><u>Challenge!</u></p> <p>Include a section to show why your product is better than a competitor's.</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature & date:</i></p> <p>.....</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Four</u></p> <p>Time to be creative! You need to use the Greek letters, which can be found via the weblink below, to create a plaque for your house or school. You need to edit and improve the text.
