<p align="center">Task One</p> <p>You will need to go on a walk to look for signs of Spring. Draw the: flowers, birds or frogs you may see in spring. Label your drawings.</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Can you find as many as 10 different things?</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p>	<p align="center">Task Two</p> <p>You will need to gather together the clothes you need for World Book Day. Draw a picture of you ready in your costume, then label your work or write a sentence to tell us what character you are. You need to wear your costumes on Thursday, 1st March. Have fun getting it all together!</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Tell us a bit about your character, which book are they in and why you like this character.</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p>	<p align="center">Task Three</p> <p>During the week beginning the 5th March, it's National Careers Week. You will need to think about what job you would like to do when you grow up and draw and write a sentence about this job.</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Can you tell us about your Mummy, Daddy or carer's jobs?</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p>	<p align="center">Task Four</p> <p>Can you find out information about the country Spain? Have you been there before? Have you eaten Spanish food? Have you dressed in Spanish clothes? <p align="center">Task Five</p> <p>You will need to find out information about a mini-beast of your choice. Draw a picture of the outside of your home and learn and write your address under the picture. You will need to tell us your address in school. Try and make your picture look like the outside of your home. Is your number on your door? What colour is your door? How many windows do you have? Etc.</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Can you remember the post-code too?</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p>	<p align="center">Task Seven</p> <p>You will need to find out why Christians celebrate Easter. Why do we give Easter eggs? What happens in the Easter story? Be able to talk about the rhyming words. Can you write the rhyming words in your book? You could also read it out on Tapestry. Learn all of it to tell your keyworker group.</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Use one of the rhyming words in your poem and list as many words that rhyme with it in your book, making a rhyming string.</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p>
