<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task One</u></p> <p>Read the diary entry of a chimney sweep at https://www.lookandlearn.com/blog/29907/the-fictional-diary-of-a-chimney-sweeps-boy/ and then write a maximum of 2 paragraphs as if you're the character in the diary entry. Explain how you feel and what happens to you. You have been asked to look at his picture of his sunflowers and create your own version of the picture. Remember what is important is to look at the patterns he uses to create the textures. Can you create your own textures to recreate this picture? What does it do? How does it work? Why is your invention the best?
