Headteacher's Message

Tuesday's parent workshop focused on parental engagement and how parents can get involved in school life at Bowmansgreen. Annabel Zatko (Chair of FOBS) and Mark Castle (Chair of Parent Council... soon to be Forum) attended the meeting to discuss how the two parent bodies have and will continue to work closely with the school, to give parents an active voice and role in supporting Bowmansgreen. The school benefits greatly from all of the fundraising, suggestions and support and we would like to build upon and increase the number of parents who get involved. We are looking for class representatives to help share ideas and information and work closely with the school, FOBS and the Parent Forum. More information will follow next week.

You may be aware that Data Protection law is changing on May 25th. Organisations, including schools, need to be ready for the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and ensure that they are compliant with the new legislation. Over the next few weeks, we will be reviewing our Privacy Policy which explains what personal information we use, how and when we use it. As part of this process, we recently sent home a request for updated emergency contact and medical information which we need to have access to, to help us keep your child safe whilst in our care. We will also be seeking renewed consent to record and use other personal information, such as photographs in school.

I always feel very proud and privileged to be the Headteacher of Bowmansgreen. Looking through this week's newsletter, it is a great illustration of what there is to be proud of. We are a school with hardworking, talented pupils and I love the opportunity to acknowledge and celebrate this.
