Your diagram must include these key symbols: wire, bulb, switch and battery.</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Can you draw another circuit with the switch open? In which circuit would the bulb be glowing? Why?</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date: </p>	<p align="center"><u>Task Two</u></p> <p>You will need to research materials that are good conductors of electricity, and ones that are good insulators. (Try and find at least six of each.) https://www.bbc.com/bitesize/articles/zxv482p Write your research up in a table.</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Can you design a safety suit that would not conduct electricity? Then research the names of two volcanoes, two tsunamis and two earthquakes and where they happened. https://superbrainybeans.com/geography/earthquakes/ (You can also use the tabs on volcanoes and tsunamis to help you.)</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Can you bake a volcano or earthquake cake? Take a picture and stick it in your book. (Don't forget, your teachers like to try your cake!)</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date: </p>	<p align="center"><u>Task Six</u></p> <p>You will need to create an advert for a holiday to visit a dormant volcano. You need to include its location and key features, as well as persuasive selling points.
