

Your child could get a Free School Meal Year 3 and above

Your child could be eligible for a FSM if

you.....

- Are in receipt of a **qualifying benefit**; and
- have a child moving from year 2 to year 3; or
- already have a child(ren) in year 3 and above.

Why apply for a FSM?

- Your child will receive a healthy nutritional meal
- It will not cost you a penny
- Applying is quick and easy

Qualifying Benefits for FSM

- Income Support
- Income based Jobseekers allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (as long as you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and you don't get more than £16,190 a year)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit (with annual earned income of more than £7,400 after tax and not including any benefits you get).

If your child is eligible for free school meals, they'll remain eligible until 2022, or until they finish their current phase of schooling (primary or secondary), if that's after 2022.

How do I Apply?

Apply by visiting <u>www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals</u> and selecting the following tab. (You will need your National Insurance Number or Home Office number to hand).



Did you know?

Registering for a FSM helps schools identify anyone on low income; the school can then claim additional funding from the government, which can help towards extra computers, books, trips out and staff etc.
