

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task One</u></p> <p>You will need to research the roles of women in WW2. Create a poster to present the information you have found. Which faith is he the leader of? 2. How was he chosen to be leader? 3. Can you write three quotes that the Dalai Lama has made which sum up his faith?</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p> <p>.....</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Three</u></p> <p>You will need to imagine you are a child in WW2 and have been evacuated from a city to the countryside. Write a letter home detailing your experiences. Consider all your senses and use examples of emotive and informal language to express how you are feeling. Your letter should be at least four paragraphs.</p> <p>Challenge! Can you include five of this week's spellings from this week's challenge? Underline them using a coloured pencil.</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p> <p>.....</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Four</u></p> <p>You will need to imagine you are a reporter for a magazine and are sent to interview a character from your class reader (London Eye Mystery). Write a series of questions followed by the answers that the character gave. Make sure you consider the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reason for the interview • Believable responses e.g. Kat would answer differently to Ted <p>Challenge! Can you present your interview in the form of an article, to include an introduction and a suitable concluding statement?</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p> <p>.....</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Five</u></p>  <p>You will need to produce a page of sketches of living things you can observe close to where you live. Make notes about their physical features, what they eat and where you found them.</p> <p>Challenge! Can you make a detailed drawing of one of the living things you have studied?</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p> <p>.....</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Six</u></p> <p>You will need to research a key historical figure from WW2, such as Winston Churchill or Eleanor Roosevelt. Ensure you use a safe website such as https://www.ducksters.com/history/world_war_ii/ or your local library. Write a biography of their life. Your biography should be at least four paragraphs long and include details of their early life, key milestones and their significance during WW2.</p> <p>Challenge! Can you include a range of simple, compound and complex sentences and a range of conjunctions in your writing?</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p> <p>.....</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Seven</u></p> <p>You will need to invent an imaginary new species which belongs to one of the five kingdoms of life - http://www.oum.ox.ac.uk/thezone/animals/animalid/kingdom.htm.</p> <p>Draw a picture of it and label each feature that helps to classify it. Describe the ideal habitat for your creature; giving reasons why it is best suited to that environment, e.g. desert, tropical rain forest, deep ocean.</p> <p>Challenge! Can you write a short diary entry of the day that you discovered your new creature?</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p> <p>.....</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Eight</u></p> <p>You will need to create a picture in the style of Pop Art on plain A4 paper. You can choose an everyday household object and present it using four different colour schemes. Write a caption to explain your choice of object.</p>  <p>Challenge! Imagine your picture is on show in a gallery and has been seen by an important art critic who really liked your work.
