Headteacher's Message

This week, we enjoyed our first celebration assembly of the year. It was lovely to be joined by our reception classes as we celebrated children across the school for their hard work and excellent behaviour. Our Y6 House Captains were also presented with their new blazers which I know they will wear with pride.

Our new back gate is now fully operational. In the afternoon, the gate will be opened by a member of staff at 2.55pm and will remain open until 3.15pm. At this time, it will close but parents can exit through the gate by pushing the green button on the side of the grey unit to the right of the gate. The gate has been set on a timer and will unlock again to allow for the pick-up from after school clubs. Please be mindful that the new gate is heavy and will close slowly. We ask that parents do not bolt the gate open and ensure that it closes securely after them.

Please be reminded that children are not to play on the playground equipment after school. Pupils are aware of these rules and we appreciate your support in reinforcing these expectations.

At Bowmansgreen, we want pupils to be able to make the most of their school environment and plan and encourage outdoor learning across the curriculum. As the weather is getting cooler, please ensure that your child has a jumper, jacket or coat for when they are playing and learning outside as it can be quite chilly when they are out of the sun. There have been some recent queries around outdoor PE uniform, particularly around suitable footwear. Our uniform policy for KS1 specifies that pupils are to wear plimsolls for PE. As the weather gets colder and damp, we would recommend that pupils also bring trainers, if they have them, which have more grip and are more durable so that they can continue to have PE outside. We will be amending our uniform policy for next year to reflect this. Please do not worry if your child does not have trainers, they will still be able to take part fully in PE lessons.

If you have questions, queries or concerns about any aspect of your child's schooling, please ensure that you see your child's class teacher in the first instance. They see your child most often and know your child well - they are more likely to have the information or answers that you require. We have an open door policy at Bowmansgreen and want parents to feel comfortable approaching teachers about their child's education so if you haven't already, please take the opportunity to introduce yourself to your child's teacher.

I look forward to seeing you at your child's curriculum meeting next week, for Y1 to Y6.
