Achievement and Progress Report

Dear Parents and Carers,

This report outlines key assessment information based on pupils' progress and achievement from last term. It focuses on the end of key stage results and in most examples, it compares Bowmansgreen results with those nationally.

These results demonstrate that Bowmansgreen is a rapidly improving school. Our results for Key Stage 2 (Year 6 SATs results) are significantly better than the previous year's. We achieved higher than the national average in reading and in reading, writing, maths combined. We also doubled the % of our pupils that reached the expected standard in all three subjects - from 34% to 68%.

We are continuing to build upon the improvements we have made in teaching and learning across the school, in all areas, to sustain the drive for improved standards and outcomes for our pupils. I am very positive about the future of Bowmansgreen Primary School and the quality of the provision that we provide for your children.

I am very proud of the staff and pupils at Bowmansgreen and their hard work and commitment and with your support, I know that we can continue to improve and enrich the quality of education that every child receives.
