If you cannot make the model, don't worry. You can draw and colour your model instead.</p> <p>Can you write a, one paragraph, blurb to go with your trophy that explains what someone must do to be nominated for this award? You may want to define what courage is and explain what acts of courage may look like.</p> <p>Challenge! Create a fact file, with at least eight facts, about them that includes the town/city, the country and the continent they play in. Make sure your fact file explains why it may be easier or harder to play there due to the weather in that location. Write a diary entry, imagining you have driven the route. In your diary, explain what it felt like to be experiencing the grand adventure. Make sure you also include at least 4 things you saw and did on your Route 66 travels.
