


Bowmansgreen Primary School

Parent/carer signature and date: </p>	<p align="center">Task Three</p> <p>You will need to design, plan and draw your ideal garden. Think about different areas of the garden and what you would like to have in each area, eg, plants, trees, a path, a play area, a water feature and an area for eating. Would there need to be any garden furniture in any of your areas? http://www.show.me.uk/interactive_game/1020-design-a-garden Challenge! Can you make a 3D model of your ideal garden? Perhaps, use recycled materials. Parent/carer signature and date: </p>	<p align="center">Task Four</p> <p>You will need to draw a diagram to show the life cycle of a flowering plant. <p align="center">Task Five</p> <p>You will need to research the Ancient Egyptian hieroglyphic alphabet and write them out. Parent/carer signature and date: </p>	<p align="center">Task Six</p> <p>You will need to draw or create your own tomb or coffin for a mummy. Can you write 3 sentences to describe your tomb/coffin? Parent/carer signature and date: </p>	<p align="center">Task Seven</p> <p>You will need to write at least seven maths calculations or word problems to solve...using Egyptian symbols!</p>  <p>Challenge! Can you ask a friend or family member to have a go at your Ancient Egyptian maths activity? You will need to teach them the symbols first!
