

Choose one Home Learning activity to complete each week. You can choose which task to complete and the order in which you do so. Task One

You will need to create your own dinosaur. You can use any material you would like, including Lego or recycled materials. You can make your dinosaur as big or as small as you want!



Challenge!

Write three facts about your dinosaur. For example, "My dinosaur is a herbivore". Remember to write down what your dinosaur is called! An adult could help you by writing down your ideas.


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Task Two

You will need to draw or paint a picture of a dinosaur. What colours do you need? Can you remember the different parts of the dinosaur?

Can you label your dinosaur?




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Task Three

You will need to ask an adult to give you 6 number sentences. For example, $3 + 4 = \dots$. How will you work these out? Will you use your fingers? Will you use objects? Write/draw the number sentences that your adult calls out to you.



Challenge!


Try adding a two-digit number to a single digit. For example, $10 + 2 =$ or $14 + 5 =$

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Task Four

You will need to make up 5 number stories. E.g. There were 10 seeds in a flower pot. 5 seeds grew. How many seeds did not grow? Write them down or you can record them on Tapestry.



Challenge!

Can you record the number sentence for each number story? For example, $10 - 5 = 5$.

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Task Five

You will need to collect a range of containers from around your home. Measure how much liquid each one holds. Order them from the least amount to the most. You could use a spoon or a cup to measure the amount in each container.



Challenge!

Can you predict how much another container holds? Write down your guess and then check to see if you are correct.

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Task Six

You will need to ask an adult to shout out a number. Write that number down and also the next two numbers (For example, an adult shouts out 13, so you write 13, 14 and 15.)

Challenge!

Repeat the activity but this time write the two numbers that come before that number. (For example, an adult shouts 11, so you write 11, 10 and 9.)

You will need to make a weather chart. You could draw symbols for rain, sun etc, write the days of the week and record what the weather is like for each day.
