




Learning Intention WALT: form letters correctly.	Key Vocabulary: Ascenders Descenders Leader lines	What you will need: Pen Crayon or felt tip Lined paper (English book)

Starter

Watch the first part of the video - the children are to copy each letter below – remember to begin with the ‘leader line’. If you do not have internet access, please copy the letters below. Notice how many letters begin in the same way as the letter c.
 (Look at the printed step-by-step handwriting guide sheet if you don’t have access to the video.)



It is also important to hold the pen or pencil correctly so that we don’t get tired hands when we do a lot of writing.

Main Teaching

Please watch the next part of the video.

Did you notice how many letters begin in the same way as the letter **c**? Can you underline them? Let's practise by writing a line of each. Join the if you can do it neatly. Also notice how high and low the ascenders and descenders go.

In the next part of the video, Mr Harnden will write two sentences for you to copy.

You are expected to complete challenge 1, 2 and 3. We will be using these sentences in the next lesson.

Challenge X is an extension challenge that you can choose if you would like to complete.

Challenge 1

Please watch the first sentence being written then pause the video and carefully copy both sentences below into your book.

Watch the last part of today's video and copy the sentences below neatly.



Learning Review


Review challenge 3 and look at the video again carefully for the 'c' starting letters, ascenders and descenders.
