If you are finding the text too tricky to read, ask an adult to read it to you and share the book together.	Answer the following questions in full sentences. 1) What does “Miss Justly ran the kitchen like a boot camp” mean? (p5) 2) Why did Eugene rush into the kitchen the next morning? (p5) 3) Why did Eugene shiver? (p5) 4) What surprised Eugene the most about being in the kitchen? (p5 or p7) 5) Why do you think Eugene got on with his lessons instead of being naughty? (p7) 6) What does “the kids scarcely touched their food” mean? (p8)

If you are finding the text too tricky to read, ask an adult to read it to you and share the book together.	Answer the following questions in full sentences. 1) Are the kitchen staff pleased with Eugene? How do you know? (p9) 2) How many pancakes did they make? (p10) 3) Who liked his pancakes? (p10) 4) What was upsetting Eugene the more he worked in the kitchen? (p12) 5) What did Stephanie suggest they do with all the leftover food? (p12) 6) How do you think Stephanie and Eugene felt about the homeless people they saw? (p12 and your own opinion)
Session 4	News and Chews by Capers White	Please read pages p13-16 independently or to an adult. If you are finding the text too tricky to read, ask an adult to read it to you and share the book together.	Answer the following questions in full sentences. 1) Why did Eugene get to work on time? (p13) 2) Explain what Eugene’s idea was. (p13) 3) Why did Miss Justly look 2as if she was going to melt? (p14) 4) Why did they make a sign? (p14) 5) How did they know their idea was working? (p14) 6) How do you think they felt when they saw the film crew? (p14)

(general) 4) How did Eugene change through this story? (general) 5) Why do you think the book is called ‘News and Chews’? (general)

Day	Follow-Up Task Answers
Session 1	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) A piece of cheese threw across the room.2) Eugene threw the cheese.3) Stephanie was a good friend to Eugene because she tried to find something he could enjoy doing at school instead of getting i nto trouble all the time. She asked him if he liked sport or art.4) Eugene threw a piece of Pizza at Ginger Ralston.5) Eugene was dwindling his thumbs and this shows he was feeling bored.6) Eugene needed to report to Thelma Justly the next day.
Session 2	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) I think boot camp means that Miss Justly is strict and makes everyone work hard.2) Eugene rushed into the kitchen because he was 15 minutes late and knew he would be in trouble.3) Eugene shivered because he was scared of Miss Justly.4) Eugene was surprised at how hard they had to work when he saw how many eggs he had to crack. OR. Eugene was surprised at how much food was wasted. OR Eugene was surprised at the amount of work they did in the kitchen preparing the food.5) I think Eugene got on with his lessons because he was too tired to be naughty.6) I think “the kids scarcely touched their food” means they did not eat very much of the food they took.
Session 3	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Yes, the kitchen staff are pleased with Eugene because Fred Turbin said, “I want you to know you’re doing a good job.” Fred Turbin works in the kitchen.2) They made 1,200 pancakes.3) Everyone liked his pancakes including Miss Justly.4) Eugene was getting more and more upset about the amount of food that was wasted. This included food that had was unopened.5) Stephanie suggested they could give the leftover food to the homeless people and her uncle could help them.6) I think Stephanie and Eugene felt frustrated about the amount of food that was wasted while the homeless people were hungry.
Session 4	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Eugene got to work on time because he needed to explain his idea to Miss Justly.2) Eugene’s idea was to give all the food they wasted every day to homeless people.3) Miss Justly looks as if she was going to melt because it meant people would finally enjoy her food instead of it going in the bin.4) They made a sign to try to stop people taking food they were not going to eat.5) They knew their idea was working when people started to bring in food for the homeless people.6) I think they felt amazed and delighted when they saw the film crew.
Session 5	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Eugene felt most annoyed when he threw the pizza at the start of the story.2) Eugene felt most scared when he first went to work in the kitchen because Miss Justly was so strict.3) I think Miss Justly was always strict because she had so much work to do and no one appreciated her food.4) Eugene has changed a lot. At the start, he was very angry and frustrated and he threw food at someone. In the middle, he was shocked by the amount of work they did in the kitchen and worried about the amount of waste there was. By the end, Eugene had not been naughty at all and he found a solution to the food waste problem. I think he felt proud and would never throw food again.5) I think the book is called ‘News and Chews’ because the news was when they became the news at the end of the book. The chews is from the food that people chew.
