Main Teaching		
<p>We are going to be looking at words that have the suffix –ation.</p> <p>The suffix ‘-ation’ can be added to verbs in order to form nouns.</p> <p>Van Gogh went on to create many masterpieces (‘create’ is a verb).</p> <p>Ted’s birthday cake was a wonderful creation (‘creation’ is a noun).</p>		

Some spelling rules to help us for adding the 'ation' suffix

If the root word ends in an e: remove the 'e' and add 'ation'
 For example: adore → ador + ation = adoration

If the root word ends in ate: remove the 'ate' and add 'ation'
 For example: locate → loc + ation = location

If the root word has a vowel before an l at the end: double the 'll' before adding 'ation'
 For example: cancel → cancell + ation = cancellation

If the root word does not end in e or l: just add 'ation'
 For example: inform → inform + ation = information




