Day	Follow-Up Task Answers
Session 1	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Isa heard the sound of her mum's scream, coming from the living room. 2) A painting of Isa's Grandma, which hung over the mantel, had gone missing. 3) Grandpa had the picture painted because he wanted to give Grandma a great, beautiful birthday present. 4) The family were surprised that the painting had been stolen because it wasn't worth a lot of money and nobody had broken into the house. 5) The painting was special because Grandpa gave the painting to Grandma and he died not long after in a war. 6) Eddie suggested that maybe one of Isa's best friends might have stolen the picture as they were visiting the house.
Session 2	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Isa told her mum that her friends would never have taken the picture because they knew how much it meant to the family. 2) Eddie thought it would be exciting to have the police involved because they would come to the house and ask lots of questions. 3) The cold fear that came over Isa was the thought that maybe her friends had been involved in stealing the picture. 4) Eddie had to back off when he said Kit was the thief because Isa yelled at him, becoming very upset. 5) Gina might have stolen the picture because she was jealous of Isa always winning and getting the praise and, perhaps, wanted to hurt Isa. 6) Kit was angry with Isa because she thought they were close friends and was hurt to think that Isa might believe the gossip.
Session 3	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Isa was asked by her parents to call her friends to see if they heard or noticed unusual when they were making their bracelets. 2) Kit said that Sandy's family were very poor and that maybe Sandy thought the picture was expensive. 3) Gina and Isa weren't close because Gina was jealous of Isa's hair, clothes, grades and for always being picked first for things.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none">4) Aunt Tati was jealous of Isa's mum because she was prettier, smarter and lived in a big house.5) Aunt Tati was mad with Grandma because she gave the picture to Maria, her sister, and not to her as the eldest.6) A police officer came to look at the wall where the picture hung, looked for clues and footprints and then wrote a report.
Session 4	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Isa felt sorry for Sandy because she was wearing old, shabby clothes.2) Isa was worried about Grandma coming to their house because she would see that the picture was missing and would be heartbroken.3) Sandy was surprised to hear that Isa's family didn't have a gardener because she saw someone clipping the bushes.4) Sandy thought it weird because it was around eight o'clock at night that he was doing the gardening.5) Maria and Tati were arguing because Tati accused Maria of being careless and losing a treasured picture of their mother.6) Aunt Tati seemed almost happy about what had happened because her sister had always been her mum's pet and now she had let the special picture be stolen.
Session 5	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Aunt Tati was mad because the words 'stomped' and 'slammed' are used to describe her actions.2) Isa's mum thought her sister was right to call her careless because she sometimes left the sliding doors open.3) Sandy said he was young with long hair and had a skateboard.4) Both characters are jealous of other people; Tati is jealous of her sister and Gina gets jealous of Isa.5) Gina shows she's jealous and gets mad when Isa gets high scores. Sometimes, she doesn't talk to Isa for days.6) Grandpa died in a war in Lebanon.
