

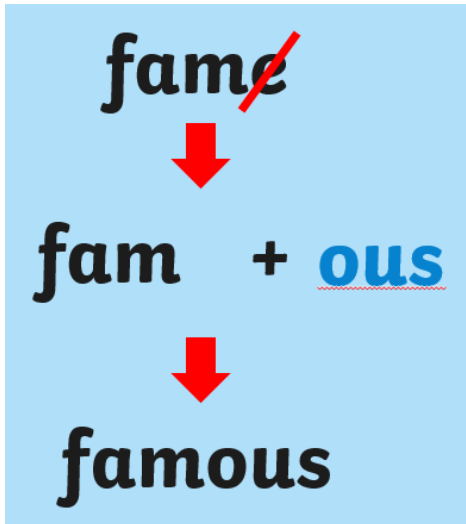

<p>Learning Intention</p> <p>WALT: use the suffix -ous on words ending with 'e' and words ending in 'age'</p>	<p>Key Vocabulary:</p> <p><b>Suffix</b> – a letter string at the end of the word</p> <p><b>Root word</b> – a basic word with no prefix or suffix added to it</p> <p><b>Antonym</b> – words with the opposite meaning</p> <p><b>Synonym</b> – words that mean the same</p> <p><b>Homophone</b> – words that sound the same but are spelt differently</p>	<p>What you will need:</p> <p>Pen</p> <p>Lined paper/English book</p> <p>Challenges</p> <p>Pencil</p> <p>Ruler</p> <p>Lesson 5 Video</p>

Main Teaching		
<p>Today, we are thinking about adding the suffix 'ous' to a group of root words that end in 'e'</p> <p>fame</p> <p>nerve</p> <p>ridicule</p>		

carnivore  
herbivore  
pore  
adventure

Before we add the suffix 'ous' we need to remove the 'e' at the end.



Add the suffix 'ous' to these words:

fame	→
nerve	→
carnivore	→
pore	→
adventure	→

What do you notice about the root words in each of these spelling words?

courageous  
advantageous

Each of these words has a root word that ends in 'ge'. This makes them an exception to our rule and we must leave the 'e' on when we add the suffix

courage → courageous

Look at each word and decide which column of the table they should go in.

	If the root word ends in 'e', remove the 'e' and add <u>-ous</u>	If the root word ends in 'ge', keep the 'e' and add <u>-ous</u> .

If the root word ends in 'y' replace it with an 'i' and add 'ous'

Eg vary = various

If the root word ends in 'our' remove the 'u' and add 'ous'

Eg odour = odorous

If the root words ends in 'e' remove it and add 'ous'

Eg pore = porous

If the root word ends in 'ge' leave the 'e' and add 'ous'

Eg courage = courageous

For all other root words just add 'ous'

Eg joy = joyous

Remember sometimes there may not be a definitive root word

Eg obvi = obvious

- Red diamond: vary, ridicule, courage

The sacks are labeled with suffix rules:

- Sack 1: -y + i, + ous
- Sack 2: + ous
- Sack 3: -e, + ous
- Sack 4: other

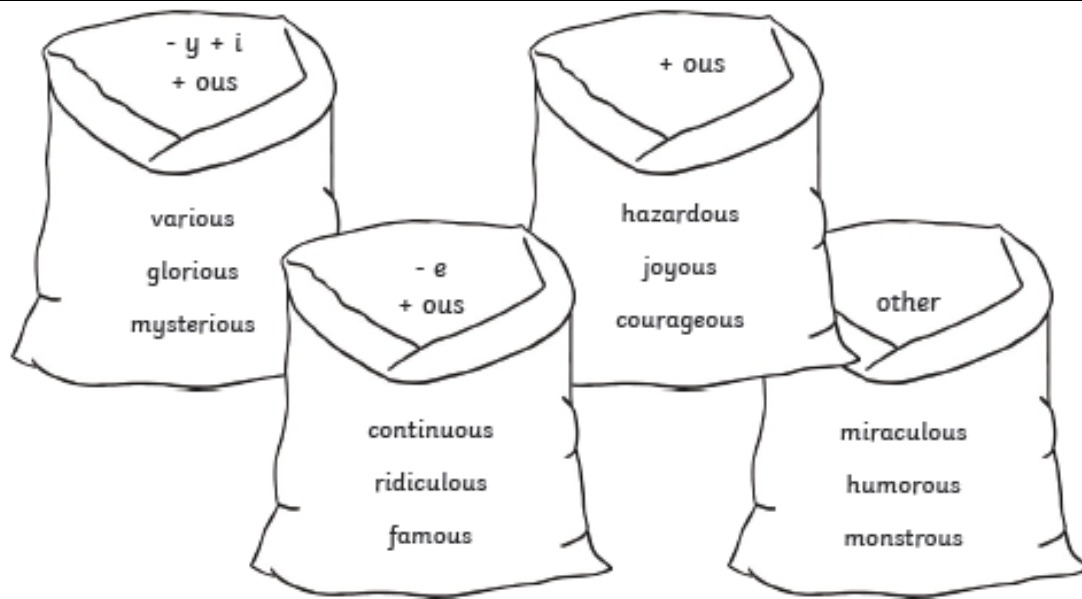

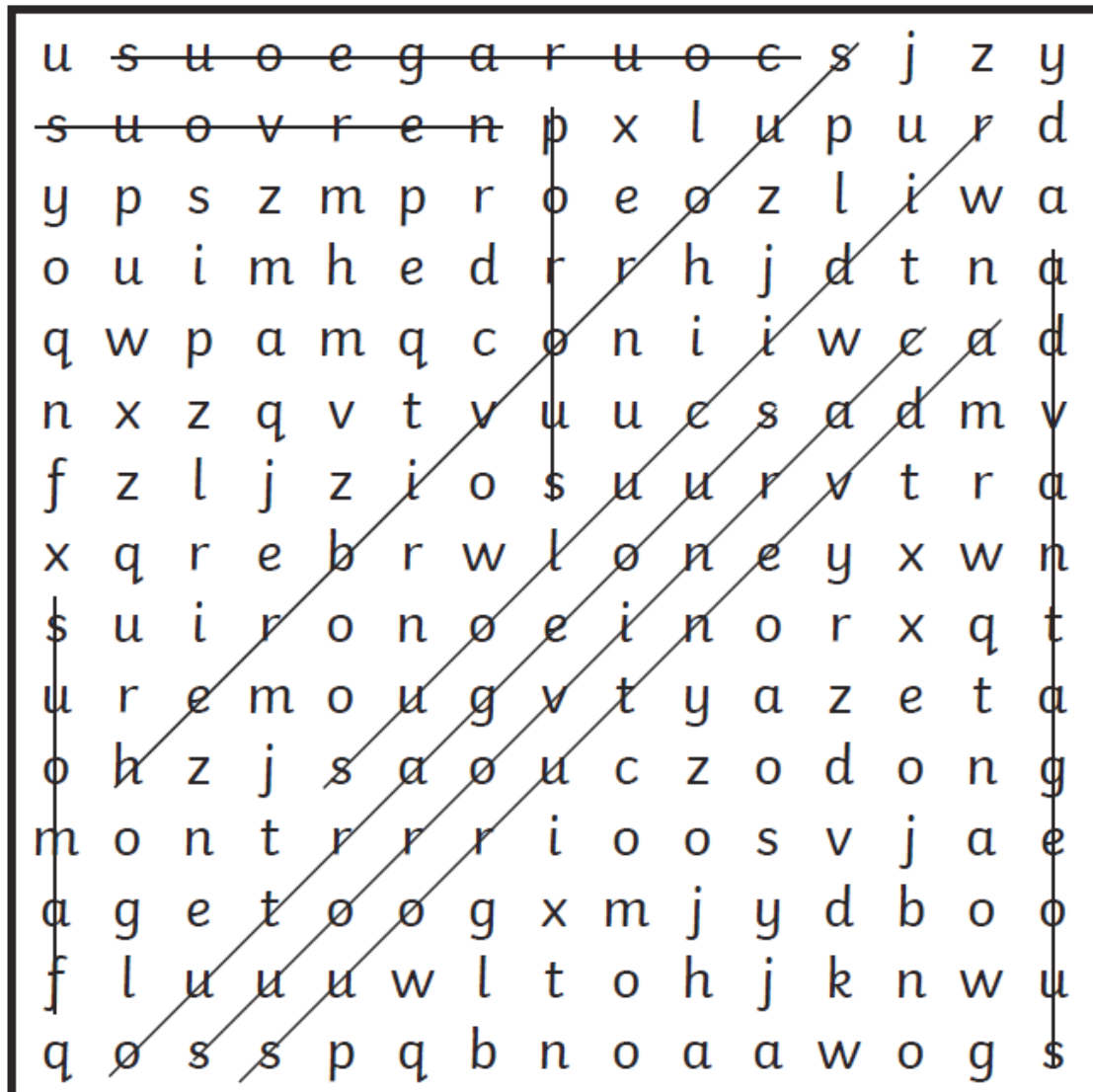
