Session 1	1) White Fang was off his food again because he sensed that Scott was leaving him. 2) Scott was going to California on a steamer. 3) White Fang escaped the house by breaking through a window because he had cuts on his face and belly. 4) San Francisco was different from where he had come because there were huge buildings, lots of humans and the ground was hard and black with wagons, cars and trolleys whizzing past him. 5) White Fang growled at Scott's mother because he thought she was trying to hurt Scott. 6) White Fang couldn't fight the collie, when it hurtled towards him, because she was female.
Session 2	1) Collie would nip and growl at White Fang, whenever they were alone, to make White Fang feel uncomfortable. 2) The stable boy lashed his whip at White Fang as he was pouncing on a chicken, and when White Fang got angry and retaliated back at the stable boy, Collie came to the rescue by barking and fighting White Fang. 3) Scott was going to train White Fang not to eat the chickens, by putting White Fang in the chicken coop, and every time White Fang killed a chicken, Scott would pay his father a dollar. 4) White Fang didn't eat the chickens because he didn't want to disappoint Scott. 5) White Fang proved to be smart when Scott was thrown off his horse, and White Fang went to get help. White Fang got the family's attention when he barked for the first time and led his father to Scott. 6) White Fang became seriously injured in a fight when he attacked an intruder, Jim Hall, during the night.
Session 3	1) The surgeon wasn't hopeful that White Fang would recover because he had a broken leg, three broken ribs, three bullet holes and had lost a lot of blood and gave him a one chance in ten thousand of surviving. 2) White Fang was determined to fight for his survival as he looked back on his life and all that he had overcome: his early adventures in the forest with

The brother of one of the children said that he was half-wolf and the mother replied, "Blessed Wolf!" after Judge Scott said that a mere dog could not have done what White Fang did. 4) The praise from the family encouraged White Fang to try to stand up. 5) Blessed Wolf was finally happy because he was relaxing in the warm sun surrounded by his loving family. 6) I enjoyed the story because it told the adventures of White Fang, half-wolf and half-dog, and the many dangerous adventures he survived to eventually find a home amongst his loving family.
<p>Session 4</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) The ancient Maya lived more than 2,300 years ago in the jungles of southern Mexico and Central America. 2) The ancient Maya were ahead of their time in writing, art and science as well as the building of their temples, pyramids and palaces. 3) Mexico, Guatemala, Belize, Honduras, and El Salvador are countries which would have been in Mesoamerica. 4) Many of the large cities were found in the southern lowlands near the sea. 5) Guatemala is west of El Salvador. 6) The Olmec lived in Mesoamerica hundreds of years before the Maya.
<p>Session 5</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Crops like corn and squash could grow because the Maya cut down trees and plants and burnt the dead growth. This process added nutrients to the soil. 2) If water was hard to find, the Maya built reservoirs to store rainwater for drinking. 3) Once the Maya became skilled farmers, people were able to settle in villages, which sometimes grew into city-states. 4) Tikal and Calakmul fought for power in the region that is now Guatemala. 5) The archaeological dig in 1956 discovered over 3,000 structures such as temples and palaces and stelae or large slabs of stone on which the ancient Maya had recorded important events. 6) Lakam Ha got its name because of its many streams.
