Day	Follow-Up Task Answers
Session 1	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) The exciting news was that there was going to be an art contest and the best painter in each grade would be selected to paint a poster.</li> <li>2) Although Gina was a good artist, she was afraid that Gina would beat her, just like she did at everything.</li> <li>3) Isa told Mr Murray she wouldn't be entering the contest because she was tired of art and learning to play the guitar.</li> <li>4) Gina was very excited when she heard the news that Isa wouldn't be entering the contest, because it says, 'she jumped up and down with excitement'.</li> <li>5) The real reason Isa didn't enter the contest was that it was more important to have Gina as a friend.</li> <li>6) On the bus, Isa wondered if Grandma knew how hurt and jealous Aunt Tati was, and thought that Grandma would have done something if she had known.</li> </ol>
Session 2	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Isa's dad told his wife to go shopping to stop her moping around the house and to help take her mind off things.</li> <li>2) Isa told her dad that she took away the chance of her winning, by not entering the contest, because she didn't want Gina to feel bad.</li> <li>3) Isa's dad was proud of her for caring about somebody else's feelings.</li> <li>4) Dad brought up the memory of playing checkers because it reminded him of how he would sometimes let Isa win and now Isa wants Gina to win.</li> <li>5) Eddie and Rafe hadn't been close as cousins because the bad feelings between their mothers had spilled over and Rafe always seemed angry.</li> <li>6) Rafe seemed glad that Isa's family were now experiencing bad luck because it was normally his family who had all the bad luck.</li> </ol>
Session 3	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Isa couldn't concentrate on her homework because she kept thinking about Rafe.</li> <li>2) Isa showed a picture of Rafe to Sandy because she wanted to know if it was the same person Sandy saw in the backyard.</li> <li>3) Sandy couldn't be sure Rafe was the person she saw clipping the bushes because the gardener was in the shadows, and the person in the picture was younger than the person she saw.</li> <li>4) They were going to tell Grandma the picture had gone when she came to their house on Sunday.</li> <li>5) Rafe said he didn't have time to talk because he was too busy skateboarding with his friends.</li> <li>6) Isa said that Rafe had been seen at their house and accused him of stealing the picture.</li> </ol>
