Day	Follow-Up Task Answers
Session 1	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) The story is set in a wolf cub's cave where an icy wind is blowing. 2) The cub couldn't sleep because he was hungry. 3) The cub left the cave because his mother, who would normally disallow him, wasn't there to stop him. 4) I think the cub met a squirrel outside the cave because the creature had a bushy tail and moved quickly up the tree, just like squirrels. 5) The cub thought it was a whole, new world because the sky was bright, the air warm and the ground soft, but not white, probably because it was spring. 6) The cub fell through the ice of a frozen river and then swept along before being washed up on the riverbank.
Session 2	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Kiche stopped snarling because he knew the people, one of whom was the brother of his owner. 2) White Fang is the name of the cub. He got his name because his mother, a dog, went to live with wolves and White Fang is part wolf. 3) White Fang viewed life in the camp with wonder and learnt that if he disobeyed the people, he would be punished, but also rewarded with meat and fish if he did as he was told. 4) The strange creature was a fire because it burnt White Fang when he went near it. 5) White Fang decided to stay with Kiche, his mother, because he was still a young puppy and needed her. 6) White Fang was finally separated from his mother when Grey Beaver traded Kiche with his friend, Three Eagles, and was taken away in a canoe.
Session 3	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) White Fang escaped camp as the tribe were leaving and packing their belongings into canoes. He crept out of camp and hid in the woods for hours. 2) He raced back to camp because he felt lonely and hungry despite being free. 3) White Fang was feeling apprehensive about entering the camp because he was worried about how Grey Beaver would react to seeing him. 4) White Fang was surprised by Grey Squirrel's reaction, because he smiled and gave him food, when he was expecting him to be angry. 5) The boy was angry and gathered a gang of friends who then attacked Mit-sah. 6) The dogs were suspicious of White Fang because he was half- wolf and much faster, more agile and fiercer than them.

Session 4

- 1) Beauty Smith was an ugly and evil man who wanted to buy White Fang from Grey Beaver.
- 2) Beauty Smith was cruel because he kept White Fang in a cage and made him fight other dogs.
- 3) White Fang was able to survive the fights because he was part-wolf and had learnt to fight with Lip-lip.
- 4) Cherokee confused White Fang by following him around the ring and not feeling any pain, despite White Fang's attacks.
- 5) Scott saved White Fang by prizing open Cherokee's jaw with his gun.
- 6) Scott became White Fang's owner by giving Beauty Smith money for him and threatening to tell the police about the illegal dog- fights.

Session 5

- 1) Scott is a kinder person than Beauty Smith because he untied White Fang, gave him some meat and smiled.
- 2) White Fang bit Scott because he was terrified and trying to defend himself.
- 3) White Fang started to relax in Scott's company because he came to realise that he wasn't going to be punished for biting him.
- 4) White Fang pulled the sled with other dogs and guarded the cabin at night.
- 5) White Fang came to trust Scott because he was kind to him; he patted and stroked him and spoke soothingly.
- 6) White Fang became miserable and ill, unable to eat, when Scott didn't return home.
