Go to the link below and pick one. You could choose to learn about Mary Anning, the architecture of the museum itself, Early life in Britain or dinosaurs. View your chosen exhibition, look carefully at the photos and read all about each one. After, make a poster advertising the exhibition. What items do you think could be redesigned, so that they do not need to plug in to your mains electricity plugs? How would you ensure that the renewable energy source was available (e.g. sun, water, wind)? Who would use your invention? Where will your invention be used? How would the original product have to be changed? Examples could include: solar powered outside toys, a television with solar panels but placed near windows, tin opener powered by the kinetic energy created by your hamster running in its wheel. Be as creative as you like! Draw and label your invention.</p> <p><b>Challenge!</b> Create an advert for your gadget.
