Learning Intention: WALT: narrative events from a different perspective to the main character's point of view.	Key Vocabulary: disappeared	What you will need: Pencil Paper
Starter (10 minutes)

Main Teaching		
<p>From the moment Noi leaves Grandma's house, we see the events from Noi's point of view. This lesson invites children to imagine what Grandma is doing before she rescues Noi and to make inductive inferences about her feelings.</p> <p>Begin by speculating, 'I wonder what happened when Grandma found Noi had gone? What do you imagine Grandma was feeling?' There are different possibilities, for example, she may have been cross, or she may have been worried.</p> <p>Ask the children to mime Grandma's reaction and invite them to choose an emotion card to accompany it. You could capture this by taking photographs or using the freeze frame technique. Continue to guide the children through further moments leading to Grandma finding Noi.</p>
