


Starter (10 minutes)

Main Teaching		
The focus for this lesson is on the section where Noi finds the bird. There is a short series of questions, the answers to which can be recorded on the How To Care For a Bird table. An adult can record the children's ideas for reference to support the writing.


Example 2

Taking Care of a Bird


Birds can be easy pets to look after. They usually live in a cage and don't make lots of mess.



What does a bird look like?



What does a bird need?




What do I need to remember about having a bird?



Some birds do not need much to play with. Chickens will happily explore a garden or outside space. Other birds like parrots need to be kept busy. They need toys to play with and to chew on.

How do I keep a bird healthy?



Birds like to be clean so their cage needs to be cleaned every day. They need to eat different foods to stay healthy like seeds, nuts and fruit. A healthy bird should have bright eyes and shiny feathers.

The children retrieve information from the text and images about caring for a bird. Begin with the page, 'Noi listened as the sea thrashed...'

- When the bird lands in the cave, what does Noi do? (Answers should refer to him being quiet and still).
- How does Noi go to the bird? (Answers should refer to him moving carefully which is inferred and staying low).
- How does Noi pick the bird up? (Look carefully at the picture to notice he is using both hands to hold it carefully).
- What do the birds eat? (Seaweed soup – tell the children that seaweed is full of vitamins and minerals).
- What is it like inside the room? (warm and dry).

Main Independent Task

Use a combination of text and images to create their guide to caring for a bird? Use the information from the story to create your care guide.

You could use the How to Care for a Bird resource below as a writing frame or create a leaflet.


