Day	Follow-Up Task Answers
Session 1	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Malvolio scolded Sir Anthony and Sir Toby because they were making lots of noise and being disrespectful, when Olivia was in mourning. 2) Maria agreed with Sir Anthony and Sir Toby that Malvolio was an arrogant snob because he was giving them orders about how they should behave and stormed out of the room, slamming the door behind. 3) Maria, Sir Toby and Sir Anthony hoped to get their revenge with Maria writing an ‘anonymous’ love letter, copying Olivia’s handwriting, and dropping it in Malvolio’s path. 4) Viola became frustrated when Orsino asked Viola to go to Olivia’s again, because Viola knew that Olivia didn’t love Orsino. 5) Viola became upset when Orsino said that no woman could love as passionately as him, because she was in love with him and told him that he was wrong. 6) Viola responded by saying that her father had a daughter who loved a man passionately and she never told him how she felt. Instead, she kept her feelings bottled up painfully inside her, and grief withered away her beauty as she pined for him forever.

Session 3	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Sir Andrew decided to leave for home because he was upset that Olivia treated Viola, the servant, better than him, and he had wanted to marry her. 2) Sir Toby tried to get Sir Andrew to stay by saying that she knew he was there and was flirting, with the servant, to make him jealous. 3) Sir Toby said that Sir Andrew would have to challenge the servant to a duel. 4) Maria said that if he won the duel he would win Olivia’s heart. 5) Sir Toby thought they wouldn’t fight because Sir Andrew was a coward, and the servant was too young and weak. 6) Sir Toby wanted Sir Andrew to stay around because of his large fortune and because he couldn’t afford all the rich food by himself.
