Main Teaching Today you are going to use your story map from yesterday to write the story of Mr Gumpy's Outing. When we are writing a story we can use phrases to sequence the story and start our sentences, they also set the scene and help the story to flow. Here are some sentences openers to use in your writing today. <u>For the beginning:</u> One fine day in summer On a fine summer day One sunny morning A few years ago Last summer <u>For the middle:</u> Next Then Later After that Some time later After a few minutes <u>For the end</u> Finally At the end of the day In the late afternoon In the evening Watch the video to see examples and modelling of sentences. Practise telling your story to another person before you start writing.		

Challenge 1

You will be using your story map to write the events of the story. In Mr Gumpy's outing, John Burningham writes what the characters said to each other and uses the pictures to tell what happens in the story. In your writing you will be writing the events of the story, what happened to the characters.

The phrases above will help you to sequence the events.

Learning Review

Look at the blurb from the back of the story book. Finish writing what happens in the story.
