This could be upside down in a tree, in a homemade den or even in your pet's bed – be imaginative! Ask an adult to take a photograph of you and bring it into school. Draw a picture of a school that you would love to go to. <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Five</u></p> <p>You will need to create a map of your journey to school, either as a model or a drawing. You can use Lego, junk modelling or a real map to show your route.</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Can you create a list of the things you see on your way to school?</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Six</u></p> <p>You will need to create a personal timeline from your birth until now. Please include at least four important events from your life on it. For example, your date of birth, house move, birth of siblings, start of school, weddings etc. Please be creative!</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Can you create a piece of artwork to illustrate one of the events on your timeline? For example, a painting of your new house, collage of a wedding etc.</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Task Seven</u></p> <p>You will need to either draw a room in your home and label the objects in it or take a photograph of a room and label the objects in it. (For example, a flat, a bungalow, a semi-detached house etc.) Then write clues for a friend to guess what type of home you live in.</p> <p>For example: My home has stairs. My home has two floors.
