We are delighted to be opening our doors up again in September and look forward to welcoming back old and new families to our Jousters after school club. We anticipate opening on Monday 7th September.

A little bit about the club....

- We are open each day after school until 6pm
- After School Club cost is £12.00 (from January 2020)
- We offer one session length, but parents can of course pick up at any time during the session

The club supervisor is Jess Jepson who has been with Jousters for over 7 years; Jess has her Level 3 in Childcare and is one of our DSPs (Designated safeguarding people). Jess Fuller is our deputy and Carli Levene is our playworker. All staff are DBS cleared and have completed safeguarding, first aid & food hygiene training.

We are based in the school dining room, located at the front of the school with daily access to outside play.

Coronavirus

We are currently looking at safety measures and risk assessments to make sure we keep your children as safe as possible while in our care.

Children will be grouped into KS1 and KS2 bubble groups with a maximum of 15 in each group, each group will be assigned to half of the dining room, children will be able to play within their groups with a regular member of staff every day.

Extra hygiene measures such as hand washing, room cleaning and not allowing parents to come on site will also be implemented. We are continuously reviewing practices and prior to opening we will have a more detailed plan for parents.

Our Daily Routine

The youngest children (KS1) are collected from their classrooms and KS2 are able to make their way to the dining room internally through the school at the end of the day, where they will be greeted by staff.

Once the children registered, they are free to choose what they would like to do from a range of toys and activities: crafts, construction, dress up, table- top games and outside play are examples of options.

Jousters offers a wonderful opportunity to support children with their social skills; sharing, taking turns, being polite and respecting each other and staff; and independent skills such as pouring drinks. We work closely with the teachers to make sure each child has the best care possible. We believe children should be able to join in with a range of fun activities and, as long as they are playing nicely and sharing, plenty of free choice. We believe children should be encouraged to play, create, build and do, or simply socialise with their friends.

Food

Children are offered a healthy snack each afternoon such as toast, pitta, crackers, fresh fruit and vegetables, water and milk with low sugar spreads, cheese and marmite. This is only a light snack and it is expected that children receive a hot meal when they get home. Please do chat to staff if your child has any allergies or intolerances - we do not allow children to bring unhealthy snacks.

School Based Clubs

Children wishing to attend school-based clubs such as netball, art or football are able to do so. We do not offer discounted sessions when part is missed. If you let the Jousters staff know we will make sure they get collected from the club when it finishes.

Key information on invoices, payments and bookings

Parents are asked to pay for sessions upfront at the start of each half term on invoice - parents can pay by most childcare vouchers, the Government Tax free childcare scheme, BACS transfer or by cheque.
