

Choose one Home Learning activity to complete each week. You can choose which task to complete and the order in which you do so. Once you have completed an activity, please ask a parent/carer to initial and date in the appropriate space. You may wish to include photographs of larger pieces of work and/or practical activities. Home learning is to be handed in by **Tuesday** each week.

<p align="center">Task One</p> <p>This term, we are looking at where our food comes from. Choose ten food items from your kitchen and read the packaging to find out where each food originated. Write down the country and continent each food comes from.</p> <p>Challenge! Thinking back to our 'History of Flight' topic, how would food have been transported before the invention of the aeroplane?</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p>	<p align="center">Task Two</p> <p>In Science, we will be looking at ways in which materials can change. E.g. by bending, twisting and folding. Take an A4 piece of paper and keep folding it in half. How many times can you do this before it becomes too difficult to tear? Write a sentence telling us how many folds you managed and why you think it became too hard to tear.</p> <p>Challenge! Repeat the activity using a different type of paper, such as card, tissue paper or wrapping paper. Write three sentences to state what you noticed and explain why this was the case.</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p>	<p align="center">Task Three</p> <p>Fireworks are used to celebrate Guy Fawkes night; but are also used to celebrate events such as Diwali and New Year's Eve. Write a poem about a firework. Include describing words which will bring your poem to life – think about your senses to help you with this.</p> <p>Challenge! Have a go at the experiment above, following the instructions carefully. Write three sentences to explain how you were able to make a firework in a glass.</p> <p>Challenge! <p align="center">Task Five</p> <p>One of our English texts this term is about 'Scaredy Squirrel' who is trying to find the perfect friend. Write a wish list for your perfect friend. How would you like your new friend to act towards you and others? What attributes make for a perfect friend? What will their interests be and how would you share your time together? Try and write at least five wishes.</p> <p>Challenge! Write an advert for the local newspaper, inviting people to interview for the position of your new, perfect friend.</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p> 	<p align="center">Task Six</p> <p>You are going to become a restaurant owner near the coast! Create your own menu for the customers, thinking about what type of food can be sourced locally to your restaurant. Remember your restaurant will be near the sea!</p> <p>Challenge! Write a customer review of someone who has eaten at your restaurant – remember to use wow words which would encourage others to eat there. Or – can you cook one of these meals with an adult at home and take a photograph of it?</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p> 	<p align="center">Task Seven</p> <p>Our RE theme this half term is tolerance and respect. Make a poster for our classroom about how we respect each other at school. You could include how we respect each other's emotions and views, personal space and each other's chance to have a turn to be heard. Don't forget to make it eye-catching and use your best presentation skills if you want it to go on display!</p> <p>Challenge!
