


Complete the planet ordering activity and the quiz on the website.</p> <p>In your book, write down the order of the planets from the closest to the furthest away from the Sun.</p> <p>Try to come up with a mnemonic sentence to help you remember the order such as:          ‘My Very Educated Mother Just Served Us Nachos’</p> <p><b>Challenge!</b>          Pluto is known as a dwarf planet. Write at least two sentences to explain what a dwarf planet is.
