

<p align="center">Task One</p> <p>Our story is 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea'. (You can listen to the story here: http://www.lovelybooks.co.uk/the-tiger-who-came-to-tea)</p> <p>Can you follow a recipe to make the tiger a cake? Use scales to measure the ingredients carefully. Look closely at how the ingredients change when you mix them together.</p>  <p>Challenge! Can you write an invitation to ask the tiger to come to your tea party?</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p>	<p align="center">Task Two</p> <p align="center">Ten fat sausages</p>  <p>Sing the song 10 fat sausages. Can you think of any actions for it? https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/nursery-rhymes-ten-fat-sausages/z6vh7nb</p> <p>Challenge! Count down from 10 to 0. Try starting from different numbers, not just 10.</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p>	<p align="center">Task Three</p> <p>Go outside in the garden or for a walk. Take a bag with you and collect some sticks and twigs. Use them to make different shapes. How many can you make?</p>  <p>Challenge! Try and make a 3D shape.</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p>	<p align="center">Task Four</p> <p>Science Experiment – Lava Lamps</p> <p>You will need a bottle or jar, water, oil, food colouring and Alka Seltzer.</p> <p>Fill the bottle/ jar ¾ full with water, add the food colouring and mix. Fill almost to the top with oil. Once settled add half an Alka Seltzer. Watch what happens. You can watch how to make a lava lamp here: https://www.science-sparks.com/how-to-make-a-lava-lamp/</p> <p>Challenge! Talk to your adult about what happened. Why do you think the oil didn't mix with the water? What happens if you add a whole tablet?</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p>	<p align="center">Task Five</p> <p>Play 'I hear with my little ear'. Listen carefully for different noises. Can you describe the noise for your partner to guess? You can play this game inside or outside.</p>  <p>Challenge! Make a different sound from things you find at home, such as hitting spoons, shaking a bottle of water.</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p>
<p align="center">Task Six</p> <p>A tiger has a stripy pattern. Can you create a new pattern for a tiger? Divide a sheet of paper into three and draw three different patterns for your tiger. Look around your home for some patterns to help you.</p>  <p>Challenge! How many different patterns can you find in your home?</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p>	<p align="center">Task Seven</p> <p>Play Disco Dice.</p> <p>Roll the dice and do the action for that number:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1: Jog on the spot 2: Star jumps 3: Side to side jumps 4: Bend down, stretch up 5: Clap under the knee 6: Touch your toes <p>Challenge! What happens to your heartbeat when you do these actions? Check your heart at the start and check it again at the end.</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p>	<p align="center">Task Eight</p> <p>You will need a sheet of paper and a crayon. Go for a walk, or into the garden. Look for some different textures and patterns. Put the paper on top and rub the crayon over it to make a rubbing. Try bark, a leaf a stick.</p>  <p>Challenge! Use your phonics to label the rubbings with what they were.</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p>	<p align="center">Task Nine</p> <p>Our topic this term is 'Food'. Can you draw a poster of all your favourite foods or meals? Label the foods on your poster.</p>  <p>Challenge! Write a sentence about why you like one of those foods.</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p>	<p align="center">Task Ten</p> <p align="center">Apple and Hoop</p> <p>You need: an apple, toothpicks and hoop cereal.</p>  <p>Ask an adult to push the toothpicks into the apple. Put cereal onto each toothpick carefully. How many did you put on?</p>  <p>Challenge! Thread the hoops onto a string to make a necklace.</p> <p>Parent/carer signature and date:</p>
