Task One

Create and design a vehicle that you could use to travel into space. What would it look like? You could create a rocket using cardboard tubes, a spacecraft using old boxes or a hot air balloon!

Make up a story about an adventure you could have in a hot-air balloon. Think about where your hot-air balloon would take you and the things you will see. Tell your story to an adult and upload a video to Tapestry.

Go for a walk with a grown-up. What letters and numbers can you see on the number plates of parked cars? Can you see any letters which appear in your name? Can you spot the numbers 1 to 9?

Look at the number problem below.

10 little aliens went flying one night until 6 flew away. How many are left?

Use a number line to help you count back to find the answer.

You will need to collect a range of containers from around your home. Measure how much liquid each one holds. Order them from the least amount to the most. You could use a spoon or a cup to measure the amount in each container.

Can you predict how much another container holds? Write down your guess and then check to see if you are correct.

You will need to ask an adult to shout out a number. Write that number down and also the next two numbers (For example, if an adult shouts out 13, you write 13, 14 and 15.)

Challenge!


Repeat the activity but this time write the two numbers that come before that number. (For example, if an adult shouts out 11, you write 11, 10 and 9.)

Challenge!


Can you predict what the weather will be like next week?
