<p style="text-align: center;">Task One</p> <p>Our school value for this half term is <i>courage and determination</i>. Think of two occasions when you have shown either of these in your life. Draw a picture of each memory and then write a short paragraph next to it which answers these questions: 1. What does your picture show? 2. Why is this a good example of you showing courage or determination – what were you afraid of or what challenge did you overcome? 3. How did you feel afterwards?</p> <p>Challenge! Make your own jar of courage! Decorate an empty jar – be as creative and colourful as possible! Each time you do something courageous, write it on a piece of paper and put it in your jar.
