<p align="center">Task One</p> <p>You will need to write a short story about an adventure a minibeast has been on! (You may need to scribe this for your child.) Act out your story and record it on Tapestry! Parent/carer signature and date:</p> <p>.....</p>	<p align="center">Task Two</p> <p>You will need to choose one sound, which you have learnt in our phonics lessons, and make a sound jar!</p> <p>Collect as many objects as you can that begin with that sound and place them in a jar. (You could also use a plastic bottle.)</p> <p>Challenge! Write one sentence that includes two or more of your objects and a tricky word. Parent/carer signature and date:</p> <p>.....</p>	<p align="center">Task Three</p> <p>Try and make a model of a minibeast! You could use playdough or cardboard boxes and tubes, yogurts pots etc. Make your favourite minibeast.</p> <p>Challenge! Write a sentence about the materials you used and about how you joined different parts of your minibeast together. Parent/carer signature and date:</p> <p>.....</p>	<p align="center">Task Four</p> <p>You will need to take a walk around a garden or any outdoor area. What minibeasts can you find? Try looking under plant pots or stones, looking on leaves or bushes or around some plants and flowers. Draw the minibeasts or take pictures and put them on Tapestry.</p> <p>Challenge! Look at your drawings or photos. Choose your favourite minibeast and label its body parts. Write a sentence explaining why it's your favourite! <p align="center">Task Five</p> <p>You will need to write your <u>full name</u>. Write it in as many different colours as you can find. Try using different types of pen, pencils, felt tips, crayons, paint etc. Fill your page with your full name! Don't forget your leading lines and to use capital letters in the correct place.</p> <p>Challenge! Can you create your full name using pasta or pipe cleaners or any 3D material? Parent/carer signature and date:</p> <p>.....</p>	<p align="center">Task Six</p> <p>You will need to choose two numbers from five to ten. Then make two different number posters all about each number.</p> <p>Include words, symbols, objects, number tracks and a number line.</p> <p>Challenge! Write as many number sentences as you can that have those answers.
