

Choose one Home Learning activity to complete each week. You can choose which task to complete and the order in which you do so. Once you have completed an activity, please ask a parent/carer to initial and date in the appropriate space. You may wish to include photographs of larger pieces of work and/or practical activities. Home learning is to be handed in by **Tuesday** each week.

<p align="center"><u>Task One</u></p> <p>We are learning to spell the days of the week and months of the year. We would like you to create a diary for one week. Please write a sentence for each day telling us what you do. You might like to include photographs or draw a picture.</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Can you include what times you complete each activity? For example, 'At 7 o'clock I wake up.' (The end of year expectation for year one is to identify o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past.)</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p>	<p align="center"><u>Task Two</u></p> <p>The 1st January saw the start of 2022. Some people like to make New Year's resolutions. (These are things people will try and achieve before the end of the year.) We would like to know at least three of your resolutions. Please write three sentences to explain your New Year's resolutions.</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Can you explain why you choose these New Year's resolutions? Research which animal it is the year of. When you eat your next meal, we would like you to create a list of words or phrases to describe it using your five senses. Please come up with at least six words or phrases. E.g. crunchy, as bright as the sun.</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> Can you put your words into descriptive sentences? <p align="center"><u>Task Five</u></p> <p>In science, we will be learning about everyday materials. Draw five different toys and label what they are. For example, a doll, car etc. Then label the toys with the material they are made from. For example, wood, metal, plastic etc.</p> <p>Which material do we use? - BBC Bitesize</p> <p><u>Challenge!</u> How many things can you find around your home that are made of more than one material?
