



**Bowmansgreen Primary School**

<p align="center"><b><u>Task One</u></b></p> <p>In History, we are learning about the Ancient Egyptians. Write two paragraphs about a club, group or community you belong to. Each paragraph needs at least 5 sentences. What do you do to show you belong? Do you wear a certain uniform? Carry out certain traditions? Attend a place at the same time every week? Are there special people who run your group or activity? How does it make you feel to 'belong' there? You will need to check your writing has capital letters, full stops and conjunctions (and, but, because etc).</p> <p><b>Challenge!</b>            Design a poster encouraging other children to join your group, or activity or community. We would like you to draw or create your own. You will need to include: capital letters, conjunctions and adjectives.</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p> <p>.....</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Task Four</u></b></p> <p>Not only did the Egyptians have different writing than ours, but they also used different numbers. We would like you to write the 3- or 4-times table using the Ancient Egyptian numbers.</p>  <p>For example:  <math>1 \times 3 = 3</math>      <math>  \times     =    </math>  <math>2 \times 3 = 6</math>      <math>   \times     =    </math>  <span style="margin-left: 200px;">   </span></p> <p><b>Challenge!</b>            Can you ask a friend or family member to have a go at your Ancient Egyptian times table questions? You will need to teach them the symbols first!</p> <p><i>Parent/carer signature and date:</i></p> <p>.....</p>
<p align="center"><b><u>Task Five</u></b></p> <p>You will need to research your favourite author. Who is it? Why did you choose them? Where were they born? Why did they become a children's author? This should be at least seven sentences long. We would like you to describe how you celebrate a festival in your family or culture, for example: Christmas, Eid, Hanukkah, Diwali or a birthday.
