The weather is getting warmer and lots of things start to grow. Try growing some plants or flowers at home. You could try planting some seeds in a pot or in your garden. Remember to give your seeds some water and put them somewhere sunny. Cress seeds grow quite quickly, or you could try planting some flowers or vegetables.

Using the letters in the word "caterpillar" or "sunflower", what other words can you make? e.g. *pat, sun.*

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Task Six

To recall double facts. You can use objects such as pasta shapes or toys to help you. Remember, when we double an amount, we add the same again. Look at the sides of the ladybird to help you.

$2 + 2 = 4$

Challenge
To recall the double facts to 5 without using objects to help you e.g. "double 1 equals 2, double 2 equals 4, double 3 equals 6, double 4 equals 8, double 5 equals 10."
